ISA wins new transmission line in Peru

- **16.6 km electric line at 220 kV**
- ***Consortio Transmantaro –CTM–, a subsidiary of ISA and EEB, will execute the project***

ISA won today, in Lima, a new public bidding to design, finance, construct, operate and maintain a transmission line at 220 kV with two segments (11.7 km aerial and 4.9 km underground). The bidding also includes expansion of the line's associated substations.

For its execution the project will be transferred to Consortio Transmantaro –CTM–, a subsidiary of ISA (60%) and EEB (40%).

The project's estimated annual revenues are close to USD 5.5 million and the maximum reference investment estimated by Proinversión is approximately USD 59.6 million. Other participants in the international public bidding were Luz del Sur S.A.A. and Abengoa S.A.

Operations will start 24 months after the date of official awarding of the project; concession term will be 30 years.

This new project will facilitate expansion of the system at 220 kV aiming to timely serve the highly increasing demand in Lima metropolitan area under appropriate quality conditions.
