CTEEP, ISA's subsidiary in Brazil, submits assessment for compensation to ANEEL

The Brazilian Electricity Regulatory Agency (Agência Nacional de Energia Elétrica –ANEEL) will have a 150-day term to disclose its final decision. The form and term for the payment will be defined by the Ministries of Mining and Energy and Finance.

On the next few days, Companhia de Transmissão de Energia Elétrica Paulista (CTEEP) will submit to the Agência Nacional de Energia Elétrica -ANEEL- an assessment in the amount of R\$ 5,186.0 million (December 31, 2012 base), in connection with the compensation for the Company's non-amortized assets, prior to May 31, 2000.

The analysis was prepared on an independent basis by Delos Consultoría Ltda., in accordance with the regulator's methodology.

ANEEL has 150 days computed from the submission date for the validation and technical analysis of the assessment; thereafter, it will publish the final value of the compensation. From that date, the Ministry of Mining and Energy and the Ministry of Finance will define the form and term for the payment.

The value mentioned herein refers to the compensation provided in article 15, paragraph 2 of Law 12783/13 that made viable the extension of concessions of the electricity sector in Brazil.
